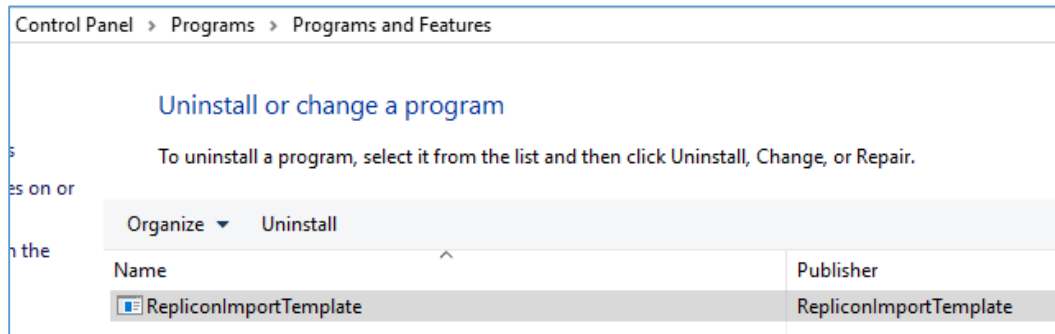


Uninstall Existing installation

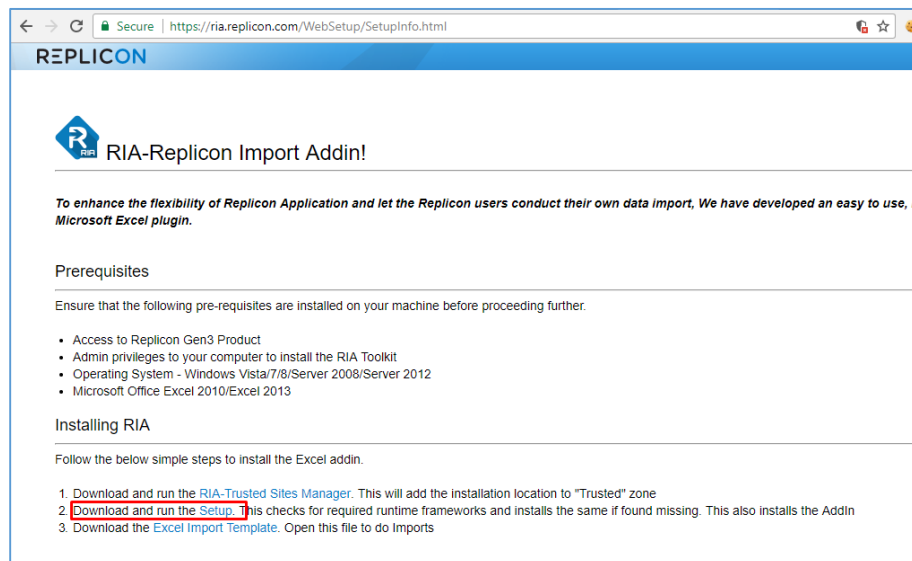
Before start installing RIA without trusted site setting, please uninstall the existing uncompleted installation. To uninstall go to

Control Panel -> Programs -> Programs and features -> search for RepliconImportTemplate and then right click and select uninstall.

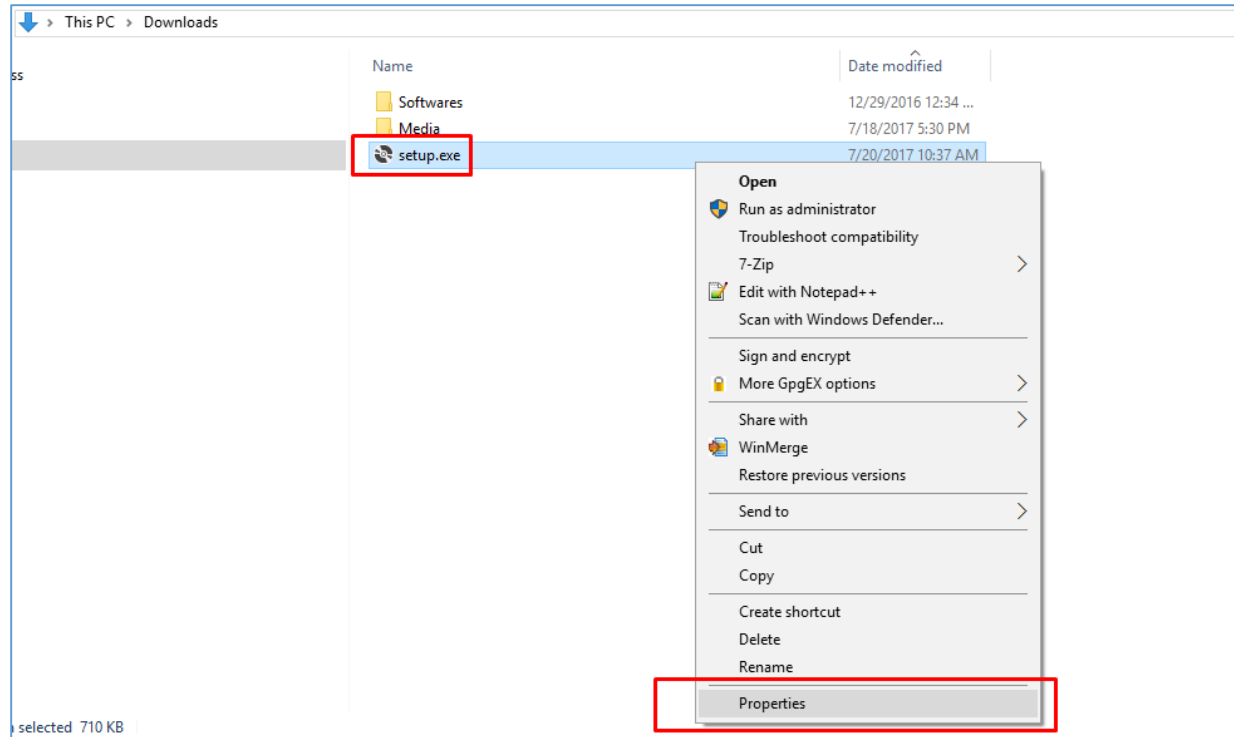


Install RIA without trusted sites

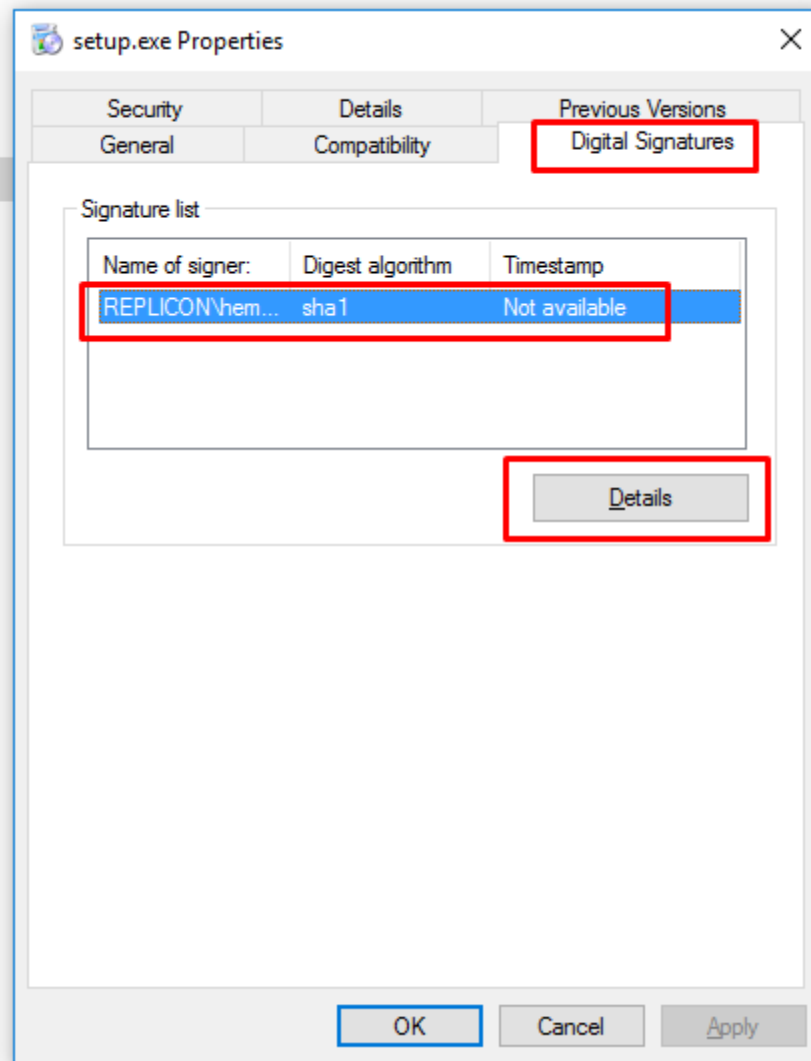
1. Download the [setup](https://ria.replicon.com) file from <https://ria.replicon.com>



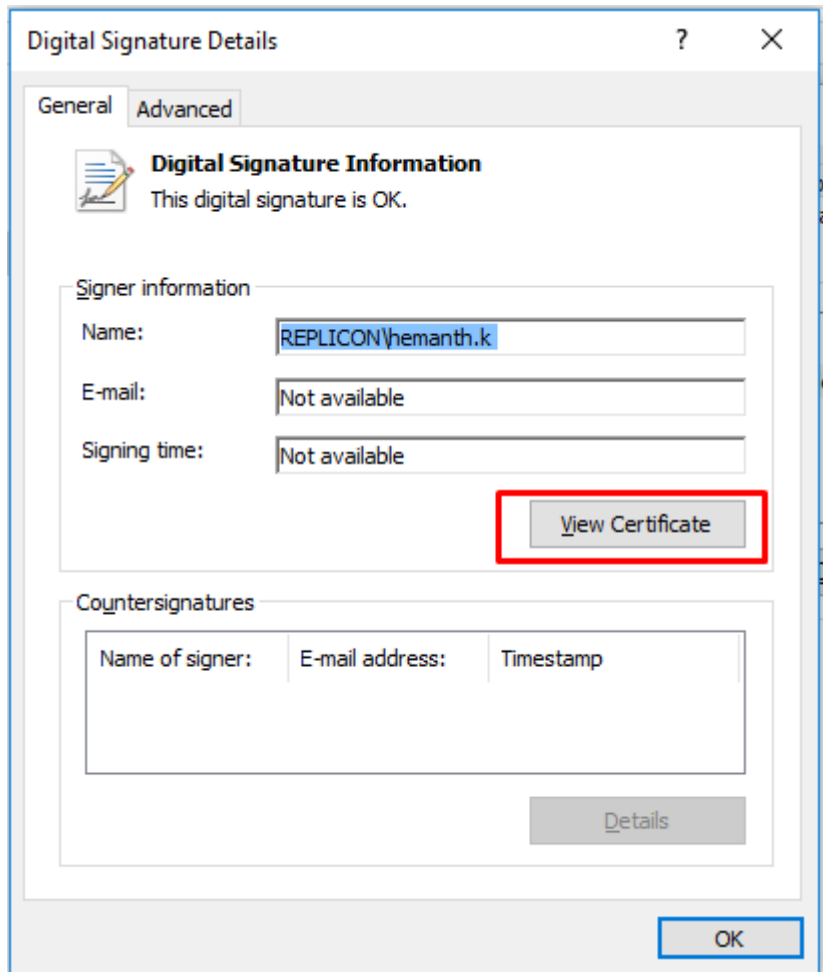
2. Open downloaded location and right click on the setup.exe



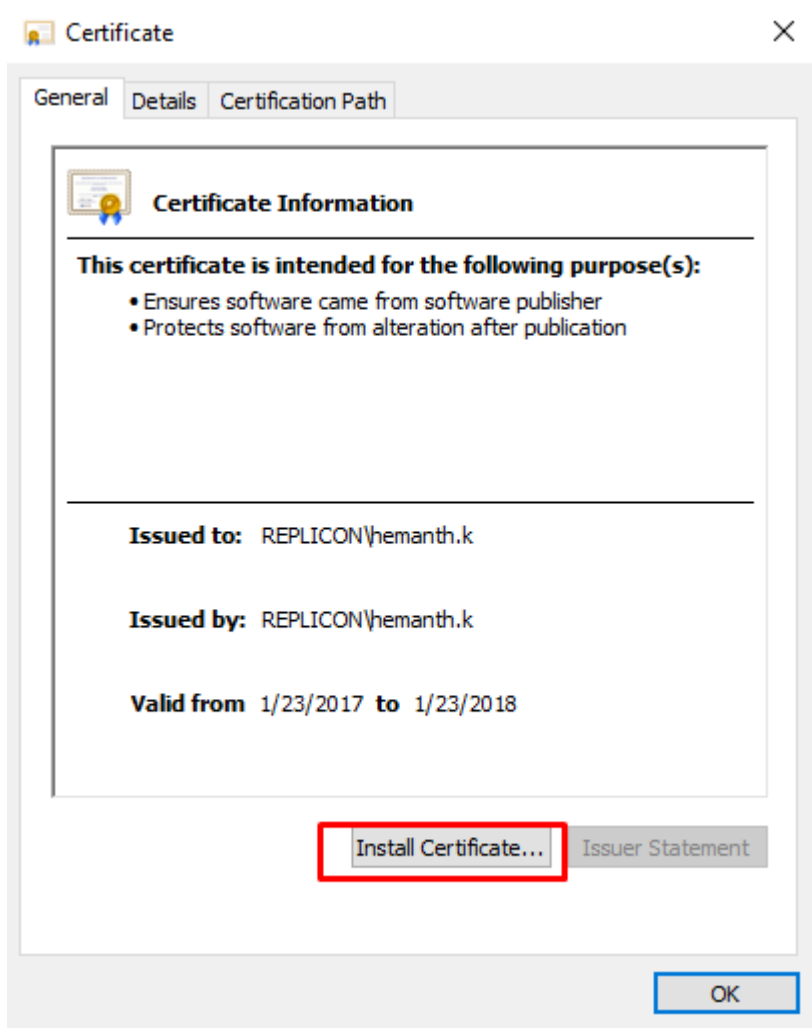
3. Select Digital Signature Tab, in the signature list select **Replicon\hemanth** and click details



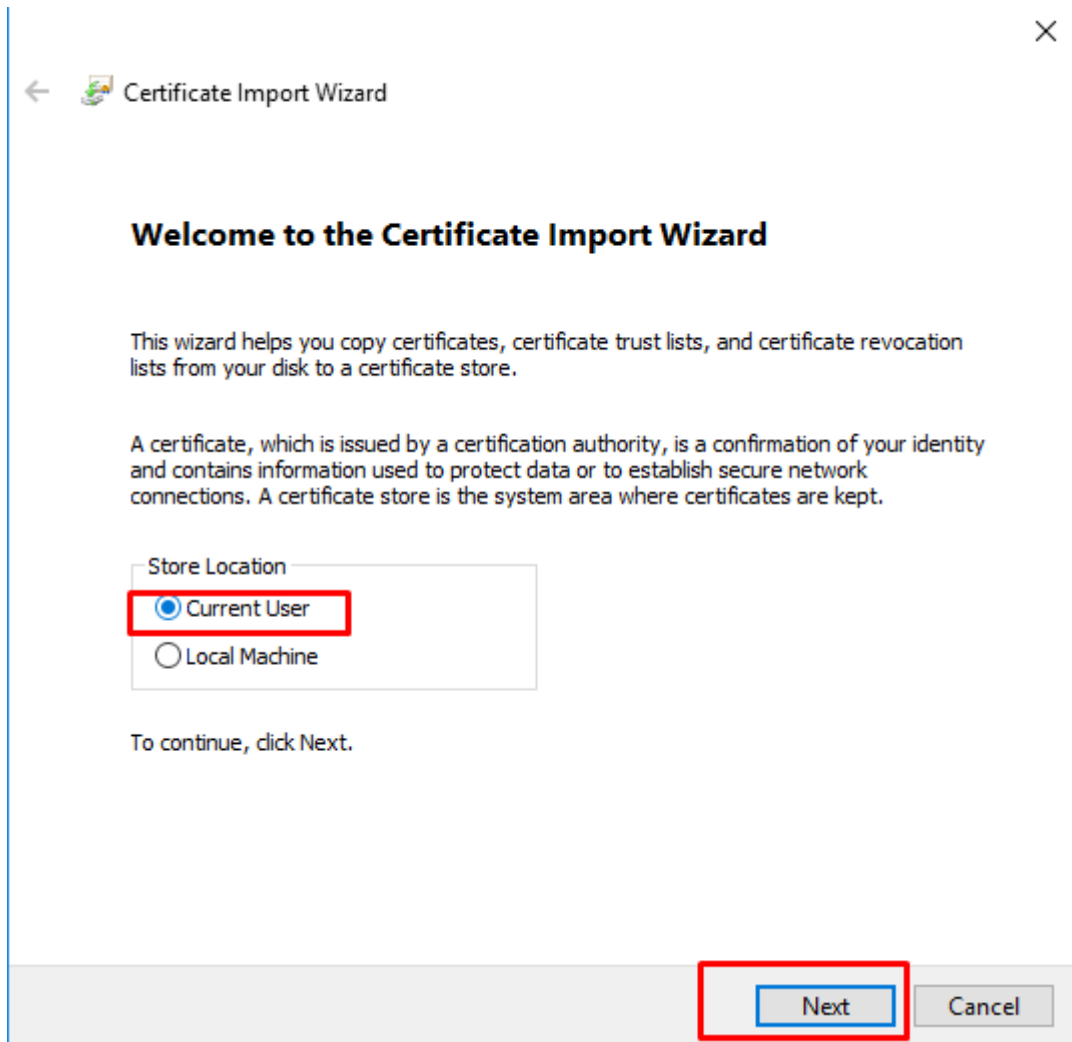
4. Select View Certificate




5. Click install certificate

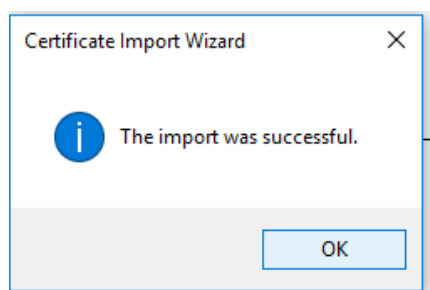
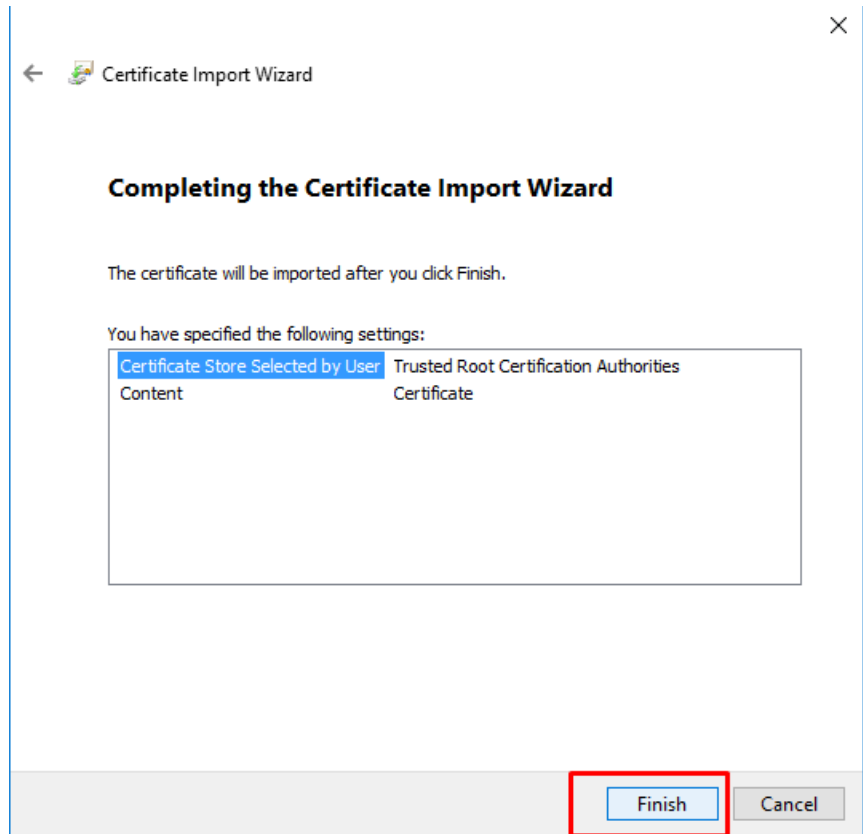
8. Select **Trusted Root Certification Authorities** Store and click ok
